Assignment 11

Due Wednesday, Oct. 16

Purpose: To record musical instrument samples.

- 1) Set up Studio One for recording into Sound Designer. Use either the mic with the XLR cable plugged into Channel 16 of the Mackie mixer (see Assignment 7 for details) or use the mic with the phone plug cable plugged into the **AM III In 1** input of the patch bay.
- 2) Set up a music stand and position the mic for the instrument that you are recording.
- 3) Launch Sound Designer and create a new file to be saved to Moog.B (internal A/V drive). Set up Sound Designer for recording as you did in Assignment 7.
- 4) Record the instrument either in separate takes or as one continuous session.
- 5) When you are finished recording, edit out unwanted material, and organize your soundfiles into folders representing the appropriate categories of sounds.
- 6) Store these sounds on your Zip disk and erase all traces of your presence on Moog.B.
