Electronic Media II MIDI Assignment 1 "Compositional Structure" handout due March 4 Vision sequence due March 13

Goals:

- 1) To create a 3 minute composition in Vision for non-pitched CyberSynth sounds.
- 2) To structure the composition so that individual sections may be processed through analog devices, then downloaded onto the Mac as digital soundfiles.
- 3) To create such a work where other sound material, such as the Casio synthesizers and digital soundfiles, may be eventually integrated with the original work.

The composition should conform to the following criteria:

- 1) The work should contain only non-pitched, short, percussive CyberSynth sounds drawn mainly from the Drum and Ethnic banks, as well as similar sounds which may be found in the other banks. Timbrally complex percussive pitched sounds may be used if they are primarily non-sustaining and are sequenced as clusters to produce a non-pitched effect.
- 2) The work should be approximately three minutes in duration and consist of 10-15 sections defined as follows:
 - a) In the handout "Compositional Structure for MIDI Assignment 1" select which parameter to use for each section for these parameter types: Length, Pause, Ensemble, Tempo, Dynamics, Density, and Timbres.
 - b) For parameter types Register and Rhythm, you may choose more than one parameter for each section.
 - c) Each parameter of the handout should be used at least once in the composition.
 - d) You should check the appropriate boxes for each sections parameters and bring it to class on Monday March 4.
- 3) The tempo of the sequence should be 120 beats per minute and the meter should be 4/4. All rhythmic, tempo, and metrical effects should be controlled by the placement of events in this tempo and meter.
- 4) Each section must begin on the downbeat of a given measure. A situation where one section ends and a new one begins in the same measure should not occur. Use the type text command in List Windows to specify the section and bar number on beat 1, unit 0 of the appropriate measure ("Section 1. M. 1", "Section 2 M. 7", etc.)
