Spring 2014 Assignment 3

- 1. Assignment 3 will be presented in class on Wednesday March 5 and Monday March 10.
- 2. As discussed earlier, everyone should meet with Will for a sit-down, to learn how to do the following in Pro Tools:
 - a. Create an instrument track, using the virtual instrument of your choice.
 - b. Create a tempo in the Edit Window ruler. For now, use one tempo and no ritards, accels, or fermatas.
 - c. Create a time signature. For now, use one time signature only. 4/4 is a very good choice, but 5/4, 3/4, or 2/4 may be used instead. Do not change time signatures yet.
- 3. Using Will as a resource, learn how to create notes for the instrument to play. Consider the following:
 - a. Grid mode is recommended for instrument notes. Be able to switch from Slip (for audio editing) to Grid for instrument editing.
 - b. Learn how to enter notes as whole notes, half-notes, quarters, eighths, 16ths, and their dotted values. Also learn how to use triplets. For now, don't use other tuples, unless you can do this confidently.
- 4. I don't expect much work to be completed yet. But, if you are ready, try composing gestures or phrases, in the following ways:
 - a. Instrument notes only, with no audio.
 - b. Audio only, with no instrument notes.
 - c. Instrument notes dominate, while audio is used sparingly.
 - d. Audio dominates, while instrument notes are used sparingly.
 - e. In using instrument notes, try to keep track of aggregate control and be conscious of any tonal implications.
- 5. Feel free to explore other possibilities not discussed.
