

Recording with the Max Soundchain Patch

- 1. Create a new folder and give it a name, such as "MySoundchains".
- 2. Navigate to the EMS Max Patches folder on the desktop. Make a copy of the Soundchain patch.
- 3. Paste the copy of the Soundchain patch into your new folder (MySoundchains).
- 4. When you record a Soundchain session, the recording will automatically be saved to the folder that the soundchain patch is located in. As long as you open the soundchain patch that is inside of your own folder (MySoundchains), then that folder is where it will save the recordings.
- 5. Clicking the button labeled "add tag word to filename" will cause a text input window to appear. The text entered will be inserted into the output audio file's name. This text cannot contain spaces.
- 6. The gray box labeled "current file" gives the filename that will be applied to the current recording. In the image below, the text "demoJonah" was typed in step 5 above.



- 7. If you do not specify a particular name, then the patch creates one for you that guarantees a unique name for each recording. The string of numbers after "demoJonah" are this unique file name.
- 8. Once the audio file has been created, you can rename it whatever you want.
- 9. To find your recordings, navigate to the file folder where you have saved the Soundchain patch. These audio files can then be dragged and dropped into your Pro Tools session, soundmined, edited, etc.
